After discussion with the Direction, we are establishing an AD HOC committee to investigate the further development of the computer curriculum at Athens College. I would appreciate your serving on this committee.

The function of the committee is to review the curriculum needs and offerings of Athens College in the computer usage. The committee should develop an approach to the curriculum, a process for reviewing it in the school and plans for implementation. This should also include an analysis of our current hardware and software.

Mr. Karamolengos has developed an initial discussion document which I am asking him to give to the committee for its review prior to your first meeting. This document is intended to promote discussion, not as a final product.

In order to begin the process, I have asked Mrs. Doriza to determine the time when you could all meet and have requested that Mr. Karamolengos coordinate the first meeting.

The College has a considerable amount of equipment, access to talent both here and elsewhere and a willing student body. Consequently, we should offer a curriculum that would make our program the number one in Greece.
